



**RULES OF THE WERRIBEE PONY CLUB**  
Affiliated with the Pony Club Association Of Victoria

1. There is to be NO bad or abusive language whilst on the PONY CLUB grounds as any time
2. Full uniform to be worn on Rally Days whether mounted or un mounted, and when mounted at competitions. To gain attendance, members must be actively involved with Club activities for the full day. This is at discretion of the D.C.
3. With the exception of watches, no jewellery is to be worn rally days.
4. Long boots/Gaiters are only to be worn by Associate riders (17 years and older) at rallies. No chaps / chappettes are to be worn.
5. New members are expected to wear the full uniform after 2 rallies.
6. No children / non-canteen duty parents are allowed in the food preparation area.
7. No horses are to be within the precinct of the clubrooms / car park area.
8. No member is to leave their riding group without the permission of the instructor.
9. No Adult is permitted within the training area unless invited by the DC or Instructor.
10. Show jumping / Cross Country is only to take place under instructors supervision.
11. All riders are required to walk only between classes. All riders leaving the grounds are to leave at a walk also.
12. Helmets are to be worn at all times whilst mounted on the grounds and no riding bareback or rugged horses permitted \*\*
13. At least fifty (50) % attendance from riding members and twenty – five (25) % from Associate (17 years old and above) is required at Club instructional rallies before being eligible to compete at competitions. Horses must have been ridden at two (2) instructional rallies to be eligible to be compete, or be graded for the following disciplines: Dressage / Showjumping / Horse Trials and Combined Training.
14. Riders are responsible for the PCAV membership cards. There are to be filled in by the DC only at rallies, and taken to every PCAV competition by the rider.
